Furthermore, we invite contributions that examine the effects of the Covid-19-pandemic and of the digitalisation it triggered both for the research on adult and continuing education and its practice.

We look forward to receiving your submissions and suggestions for topics. You are also welcome to send us outlines of ideas that can be further developed subsequently. All contributions undergo a double-blind peer review process.

The editorial team accepts manuscripts for first and sole publication only.
